Welcome to the Little Illini Soccer Club! The Little Illini Soccer Club's mission is to offer all young players the opportunity to reach their full potential in soccer by providing them with a safe, fun and challenging environment. Please review the following information in regards to registration and what steps need to be done.

Registration will be from 6-8 pm, Wednesday, November 4th at the Savoy Recreation Center (402 Graham Dr., Savoy, 61874) in the activity room. Players and parents must come to registration to secure a place on a team. Registration information and additional forms are available on the web site or under the forms link, www.liscsoccer.com. Please bring completed forms with you to registration. Registration will include: signatures for player cards, paying installment of dues, medical waivers (please sign these at the registration in front of a notary), LISC agreements, secure a player number, and sign up for Spring Cup tournament volunteer duties. **Players will not be eligible to play until payment is made and forms are completed and signed.**

Please bring to registration:

1. The player in order to provide signature for player card
2. 1x1 picture of player
3. Medical waiver (will be notarized on site or you may bring a notarized copy. Forms are available at <http://www.liscsoccer.com> under the forms link)
4. Copy of the health insurance card (for coach's records)
5. Parent and player agreement (see attached)
6. The parent/guardian must be present to sign the Spring Cup Volunteer sign up sheet
7. Copy of the player's birth certificate (new players only)
8. Dues payment in full or installment option (scholarships available upon request)

Uniforms must be ordered for ALL LISC players at Soccer Country (1710 W. Bradley, Champaign). At registration, all players, new and returning, must stop by the jersey number assignment table. Our club is attempting to centralize our numbering system so there are fewer conflicting numbers in combined age groups or if a player guest plays with another team. LISC Parental Contract

By signing this contract, I agree to become a member of the Little Illini Soccer Club, and understand that such membership entails the following obligations:

- Pay all the required fees listed in the registration packet when they are due or that will result in the removal of my child's player card and he/she will be unable to play until dues are paid.
- My child must attend at least 2 training sessions a week in the spring and be on time with appropriate attire, ball and water. The coach is to be notified preferably two hours in advance if a player will miss practice or at least two weeks prior to a tournament (to allow time for registration of guest players). Failure to do so on a consistent basis could result in suspension from team.
- Volunteer at least 3 hours of service to the Spring Cup Tournament in Champaign-Urbana from May 7th-9th. For HS Girls/Boys you will only need to volunteer for the season in which you play.
- Assume a fair share of responsibility for Club and team assignments such as field work, travel arrangements, maps, field work, communication, etc. (your coach will have a list of needed volunteer positions in which you will assign them at your team meeting)
- Abide by Little Illini Soccer Club and Illinois Youth Soccer Association guidelines for parent behavior at practices and games. Failure to do so could result in removal from games/practices.
- Review the policy manual/procedures if situations are to arise during the season and be aware of the policies of the LISC (www.liscsoccer.com)
- Review and agree to the scholarship expectations set forth by LISC at www.liscsoccer.com under the forms link.
- Will follow the step-by-step process in the policy manual when there are issues with a coach.

The coach is to be notified preferably 2 hours in advance if a player will miss practice and at least two weeks prior to a tournament.

- Bring any concerns to the attention of the team's coach or coach's representative.
- I understand that by failure to attend training sessions/games will result in follow up from the coach and possible suspension from practice/games.
